




Directions: Answer the addition and subtraction story problems. Circle the words that tell you to either add or subtract. Write your solution sentences in the blank below and remember to label your answers.

Nick has 5 books. He buys 9 more books. How many books does he have in all?






Tom has 11 cups. Sam has 9 cups. How many cups do they have altogether?
